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ORDINANCE NO. 2017-10

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 24 (SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT FEES), ARTICLE IX OF CITY ORDINANCE NO. 2014-16 OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE ZERO WASTE ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ALAMINOS, PANGASINAN MODIFYING ITS MODE OF PAYMENT, PRESCRIBING FEES FOR OTHER SERVICES OR BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENTS AND PROVIDING INCENTIVES THEREOF

WHEREAS, in furtherance to its commitment to protect, preserve and conserve the ecosystem of the locality and ensure protection of public health and the environment, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Alaminos duly enacted City Ordinance No. 2014-16 otherwise known as the "Zero Waste Ordinance of the City of Alaminos, Pangasinan" on August 19, 2014;

WHEREAS, in line with the DENR-NSWMC approved 10 year (2015-2025) Solid Waste Management Plan of the City, the Local Government Unit of Alaminos City, Pangasinan is currently intensifying its program related to the general hygiene and sanitation, beautification, and solid waste collection;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 153 of Republic Act No.7160 in relation to Section 47 of the Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000, Section 24 of Article IX of City Ordinance No. 2014-16 provides for the Solid Waste Management Fees in the City of Alaminos;

WHEREAS, after thorough assessment of the implementation of the Zero Waste Ordinance in the City, the City General Services Office recommended that the fees provided for under the Zero Waste Ordinance need to be amended to reflect the real situation in the locality in terms of solid waste management and to ensure the viability and sustainability of the Solid Waste Management Plan;

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NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Councilor Joselito O. Fontelera, co-sponsored by Councilor Rufina J. Gabriel, duly seconded by Councilor Alfred Felix E. de Castro, Councilor Cirilo B. Radoc, Councilor Froebel A. Ranoy and Liga ng mga Barangay President Raul B. Bacay

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Alaminos City, Pangasinan in Regular Session assembled that:

SECTION 1. Title. - This ordinance shall be known as an **"ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 24 (Solid Waste Management Fees), ARTICLE IX OF THE ZERO WASTE ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ALAMINOS, PANGASINAN MODIFYING ITS MODE OF PAYMENT, PRESCRIBING FEES FOR OTHER SERVICES OR BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENTS AND PROVIDING INCENTIVE THEREOF."**

SECTION 2. Section 24 of Article IX of Ordinance No. 2014-16 is hereby amended as follows:

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SECTION 4. Penalty. - A surcharge of Twenty Percent (20%) of the unpaid balance shall be charged as penalty for non-payment of applicable fees on time.

SECTION 5. Exemption from payment of SWM Fees. - The fees for Lessors/Operators of establishment/s shall depend on its business activity. Business establishments that do not generate wastes shall be exempt from the payment of fees.

Lessors of buildings without office and/or without personnel/employee shall likewise be exempt from the payment of fees.

Government facilities and offices located within the daily service collection areas of the city government of Alaminos are exempt from the payment of Solid Waste Management Fees. However, it shall be the discretion of the Barangay Council that provides collection service to a government school within their jurisdiction to collect reasonable fees provided that the collecting barangay must have the following:

- (a) Solid Waste Management Ordinance duly enacted;
- (b) Waste Collection Service;
- (c) Functional Materials Recovery Facilities (MRF); and
- (d) Barangay Solid Waste Management Plan.


SECTION 6. City's share in the Barangay collection from Households. - Twenty percent (20%) of the fees collected by the barangay shall be remitted to the City Treasury Office to compensate for the collection of residuals from the Materials Recovery Facility (MRF).

SECTION 7. Incentive Mechanism. - A monetary incentive shall be awarded to officer/s who cause/s the apprehension of violator/s under the Zero Waste Ordinance at the rate of Twenty Percent (20%) of the corresponding penalty/fine imposed.


SECTION 8. Repealing Clause. - All ordinances, rules and regulations inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed/amended or modified accordingly.

SECTION 9. Effectivity Clause - This ordinance shall take effect upon approval and after due compliance with the requirements of publication.






