**ORDINANCE NO. 2020-12**

**ORDINANCE LOCALIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (DOTr) GUIDELINES ON TRANSPORTATION APPLICABLE TO THE CITY OF ALAMINOS, PANGASINAN FOR THE DURATION OF COMMUNITY QUARANTINE AND ANY EXTENSION THEREOF**

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

**WHEREAS**, Presidential Proclamation No. 929, series of 2020, declared a State of Calamity throughout the Philippines and imposed an Enhanced Community Quarantine in the entire Luzon due to Coronavirus Disease 19;

**WHEREAS**, the Inter-Agency Task Force on Emerging Infectious Disease (IATF), on 15 May 2020, issued IATF Resolution No. 30 providing for the Omnibus Guidelines on the Implementation of Community Quarantine in the Philippines;

**WHEREAS**, Executive Order No. 0024-2020-A, issued on 18 May 2020 by Provincial Governor Amado I. Espino III, provides for the Implementing Guidelines on General Community Quarantine in the Province of Pangasinan;

**WHEREAS**, to provide for specific mechanism to strictly impose the guidelines provided for under the Department of Transportation on measures to prevent the spread of Coronavirus disease 19 in the city this ordinance is hereby enacted;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, on motion of Councilor Carolyn D. Sison, duly seconded by Councilor Cirilo B. Radoc, Councilor Froebel A. Ranoy and Councilor Dahlia M. de Leon;

**SECTION 1. TITLE.** — This Ordinance shall be known as “Transport Guidelines During Community Quarantine Ordinance.”

**SECTION 2. SCOPE.** — This Ordinance shall cover all types of transportation in the City of Alaminos, Pangasinan.

**SECTION 3. DEFINITION OF TERMS.** — When used in this ordinance, the following words and phrases shall mean:

1. **Authorized Persons Outside Residence (APOR)** – those who were listed as exempted from the quarantine by the Inter-Agency Task Force (IATF) on Emerging Infectious Diseases.
2. **Inter-Agency Task Force (IATF) on Emerging Infectious Diseases** – a joint task force duly constituted by the President of the Philippines organized to respond to affairs concerning emerging infectious disease in the Philippines.
3. **Community Quarantine** – refers to the restriction of movement within, into, or out of the area of quarantine of individuals, large groups of people, or communities, designed to reduce the likelihood of transmission of COVID-19 among persons in and to persons outside of the affected area.
4. **COVID-19** – refers to the Coronavirus Disease 2019 which is caused by the virus known as the severe acute respiratory syndrome coronavirus 2 (SARS-CoV-2)..

**SECTION 4. REGULATORY PROVISION.** —

1. PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION in the City of Alaminos, Pangasinan will RESUME OPERATIONS at REDUCED CAPACITY to ensure compliance with strict safety measures against COVID-19 transmission.
2. SAFETY refers to guidelines that REDUCE contact, transmission, and spread of the virus through the MANDATORY USE of face masks and gloves for drivers and social/physical distancing. Thorough DISINFECTING practices of vehicles, terminals, and even among passengers are also required.
3. CAPACITY and passenger load factors will be required for each mode of transportation to ensure that physical distancing is followed, to wit:
  - a. Passenger load for public utility buses (PUBs) and public utility jeepneys (PUJs) SHOULD NOT EXCEED 50 percent or half of the vehicle’s capacity, excluding driver and conductor.
  - b. For UV Express passenger load SHOULD NOT EXCEED TWO PASSENGERS PER ROW, except for the driver’s row where only one passenger is allowed
  - c. Tricycles must NOT EXCEED ONE PASSENGER in the side-car, while **back riding will not be allowed.**
  - d. Private cars and motorcycles will be allowed to operate for the purpose of essential travels as defined by the Inter-Agency Task Force (IATF).
  - e. Private cars will only be allowed ONE PASSENGER to occupy the front passenger seat, while FRONT-FACING seats shall not exceed TWO PASSENGERS per row.
  - f. Motorcycles are PROHIBITED from having BACKRIDE passengers. Meanwhile, the use of BICYCLES and similar devices are also highly encouraged

**SECTION 5. PENALTIES.** — Any person found violating any provision of this ordinance shall be fined/penalized as follows:

First Offense:	Fine of ₱2,000.00
Second Offense:	Fine of ₱3,000.00
Third and/or succeeding Offenses:	Fine of ₱4,000.00 and/or imprisonment of 1 to 6 months upon discretion of the court.


**SECTION 6. — REPEALING CLAUSE.** All existing ordinances, City Executive Orders or provisions thereof inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

**SECTION 7. — SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.** If, for any reason, any provision, section or portion of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid, the other sections or provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.


**SECTION 8. EFFECTIVITY.** — This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval.
