**ORDINANCE NO. 2020-16**

**ORDINANCE LIFTING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF THE FOLLOWING TOURIST SPOTS IN THE CITY OF ALAMINOS, PANGASINAN STARTING JULY 1, 2020, TO WIT:**

1. HUNDRED ISLANDS NATIONAL PARK;
2. LUCAP PARK;
3. E-KAWAYAN FACTORY;
4. BUED MANGROVE PARK; AND
5. BOLO BEACH

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

**WHEREAS**, the current threat of COVID-19 in the locality necessitates the implementation of stringent measures to contain the spread of the virus and ensure that the people are protected from such;

**WHEREAS**, one of the recommended measures in containing the spread of this highly contagious disease is social distancing which was reiterated in national government agencies' issuances;

**WHEREAS**, in compliance to the duly issued guidelines and protocols of the duly constituted authorities, this august body duly enacted Ordinance No. 2020-02 providing for the temporary closure of tourist spots in the city from March 18, 2020 to April 14, 2020;

**WHEREAS**, on 24 April 2020, President Rodrigo Roa Duterte announced the extension of the enhanced community quarantine to certain provinces in the country, including the Province of Pangasinan, until May 15, 2020;

**WHEREAS**, in conformity with the announcement of the President, this august body duly enacted Ordinance No. 2020-07, series of 2020 providing for the extension of the period of temporary closure of the tourist spots in the city until May 15, 2020 guided by the guidelines and protocols for communities under Enhanced Community Quarantine;

**WHEREAS**, the Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Disease thru IATF Resolution No. 37, series of 2020 placed the Province of Pangasinan from Enhanced Community Quarantine (ECQ) to General Community Quarantine (GCQ) wherein the guidelines and protocols under General Community Quarantine provides for the same stringent measure for social distancing and is therefore imperative to extend the temporary closure of tourist spots in the city, thus the august body again extended the period of temporary closure of the above cited tourist spots until the community quarantine is lifted thru Ordinance No. 2020-09 dated 19 May 2020;

**WHEREAS**, the recent imposition of a modified general community quarantine (MGCQ) in the Province of Pangasinan provides for a less stringent guidelines and protocols;

**WHEREAS**, the City Government of Alaminos, Pangasinan after thorough evaluation of the current situation of the city, intends to lift the temporary closure of the above cited tourist spots and start accepting guests coming from the First District of Pangasinan starting July 1, 2020;

**WHEREAS**, the lifting of the temporary closure of the said tourist spots shall carry with it the provision on minimum health protocols;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, on motion of Councilor Carolyn D. Sison, duly seconded by Councilor Oscar A. Boling, Councilor Apolonia G. Bacay and Councilor Michelle S. Segundera,

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD OF ALAMINOS CITY IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED:**

**SECTION 1. TITLE. - ORDINANCE LIFTING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF THE FOLLOWING TOURIST SPOTS IN THE CITY OF ALAMINOS, PANGASINAN STARTING JULY 1, 2020, TO WIT:**

1. HUNDRED ISLANDS NATIONAL PARK;
2. LUCAP PARK;
3. E-KAWAYAN FACTORY;
4. BUED MANGROVE PARK; AND
5. BOLO BEACH

**SECTION 2. GENERAL POLICY:**

1. That only guests/visitors coming from the First District of Pangasinan shall be allowed to visit these tourist spots;
2. That only fifty percent (50%) of the carrying capacity for these tourist spots shall be accommodated at one time;
3. That minimum health protocols shall be observed within these tourist spots, such as but not limited to, social distancing, wearing of face mask and provision of hand washing/sanitizing area and undergoing thermal scanning;
4. That the City Tourism Office, in coordination with the Crisis Management Team and the City Health Office, shall prepare the specific guidelines in the implementation of the provisions of this ordinance and submit the same to the august body for ratification.

**SECTION 3. REPEALING CLAUSE. - Any City Ordinance contrary to or inconsistent with any of the provisions of this Ordinance is hereby repealed and/or modified accordingly.**

**SECTION 5. EFFECTIVITY.** - This ordinance shall take effect upon approval.






