**AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE TEMPORARY FULL CLOSURE OF THE FOLLOWING STREETS IN THE CITY OF ALAMINOS, PANGASINAN, TO WIT:**

**PORTION OF QUEZON AVENUE, FROM THE INTERSECTION OF C.P. GARCIA STREET AND QUEZON AVENUE TO THE INTERSECTION OF QUEZON AVENUE AND VERECIANO STREET (FROM FRONT OF ALAMINOS CITY HALL TO FRONT OF NEPO MART), AND PORTION OF MARCOS AVENUE (FROM THE INTERSECTION OF QUEZON AVENUE AND MARCOS AVENUE TO THE GENERIC PHARMACY), AND THE INTERSECTION OF F. REINOSO STREET AND QUEZON AVENUE AND HORACIO SISON STREET AND QUEZON AVENUE ON MARCH 18, 2023 FROM TEN O'CLOCK IN THE MORNING TO TWELVE O'CLOCK MIDNIGHT (10:00 AM TO 12:00 MIDNIGHT) FOR THE LIGHT PARADE AND STREET DANCING COMPETITION**

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

**WHEREAS**, Article 43 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that *“An LGU, may, through an ordinance, permanently or temporarily close or open any road, alley, park, or square within its jurisdiction;”*

**WHEREAS**, Article 45 (a) of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of the same Code further provides in part, that *“Any national or local road, alley, park, or square may be temporarily closed during actual emergency or fiesta celebrations, public rallies, agricultural or industrial fairs, or undertaking of public works and highways, telecommunications, and waterworks projects xxx;”*

**WHEREAS**, as a long-held tradition, the City of Alaminos, Pangasinan has been celebrating the Hundred Islands Festival during the month of March of every year which also coincides with the city fiesta;

**WHEREAS**, since many activities and events were lined-up for the occasion, there is a need to temporarily close portions of roads and plaza within the central business district to serve as venues of the activities and events;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, on motion of Councilor Verna S. D. Rabago, duly seconded by all members present

**BE IT ENACTED** by the Sangguniang Panlungsod in session duly assembled that:

**SECTION 1. Title - AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE TEMPORARY FULL CLOSURE OF THE FOLLOWING STREETS IN THE CITY OF ALAMINOS, PANGASINAN, TO WIT:**

*PORTION OF QUEZON AVENUE, FROM THE INTERSECTION OF C.P. GARCIA STREET AND QUEZON AVENUE TO THE INTERSECTION OF QUEZON AVENUE AND VERECIANO STREET (FROM FRONT OF ALAMINOS CITY HALL TO FRONT OF NEPO MART), AND PORTION OF MARCOS AVENUE (FROM THE INTERSECTION OF QUEZON AVENUE AND MARCOS AVENUE TO THE GENERIC PHARMACY), AND THE INTERSECTION OF F. REINOSO STREET AND QUEZON AVENUE AND HORACIO SISON STREET AND QUEZON AVENUE ON MARCH 18, 2023 FROM TEN O’CLOCK IN THE MORNING TO TWELVE O’CLOCK MIDNIGHT (10:00 AM TO 12:00 MIDNIGHT) FOR THE LIGHT PARADE AND STREET DANCING COMPETITION.*

**SECTION 2. General Provision** - In line with the celebration of the Hundred Islands Festival 2023, the following streets are hereby temporarily closed for the specified duration, to wit:

*Portion of Quezon Avenue, from the intersection of C.P. Garcia Street and Quezon Avenue to the intersection of Quezon Avenue and Vereciano Street (from front of Alaminos City Hall to front of Nepo Mart), and portion of Marcos Avenue (from the intersection of Quezon Avenue and Marcos Avenue to the Generic Pharmacy), and the intersection of F. Reinoso Street and Quezon Avenue and Horacio Sison Street and Quezon Avenue on March 18, 2023 from Ten o'clock in the morning to Twelve o'clock midnight (10:00 am to 12:00 midnight) for the Light Parade And Street Dancing Competition.*













**SECTION 3. Effectivity Clause** - This ordinance shall take effect upon approval.
