
**ORDINANCE NO. 2023-09**

**AN ORDINANCE RENAMING THE SPORTS DEVELOPMENT OFFICE TO YOUTH AND SPORTS DEVELOPMENT OFFICE, RETITLING THE POSITION OF SPORTS DEVELOPMENT OFFICER 1 TO YOUTH DEVELOPMENT OFFICER 1 WITH SAME SALARY GRADE AND QUALIFICATION STANDARDS, THEREBY AMENDING SECTION I AND II (A) OF ORDINANCE NO. 2021-26, KNOWN AS AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE CITY SPORTS DEVELOPMENT OFFICE IN THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF THE CITY OF ALAMINOS, PANGASINAN**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Article I Section 2 of Republic Act No. 10588, otherwise known as the *"Palarong Pambansa Act of 2013"*, which states that it is the policy of the State to promote physical education and encourage sports programs, league competitions and amateur sports, including training for international competitions, to foster self-discipline, teamwork, and excellence for the development of a healthy and alert citizenry through the institutionalization of the Palarong Pambansa as the country's premier national sporting event, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Alaminos, Pangasinan institutionalized sports development in the city by creating the City Sports Development Office through Ordinance No. 2021-26 duly enacted on 07 September 2021;

**WHEREAS**, Article II Section 13 of the 1987 Philippine Constitution provides that *“the State recognizes the vital role of the youth in nation building and shall promote and protect their physical, moral, spiritual, intellectual, and social well-being. It shall inculcate in the youth patriotism and nationalism and encourage their involvement in public and civic affairs”*;

**WHEREAS**, both local and international research are providing increasing evidence that positive youth development is dependent on offering intentional programming, as participation alone does not result in growth. Accordingly, youth sports provides a context in which various positive outcomes may occur for youth participation and these include, but are not limited to, physical fitness, self-esteem, self-confidence, social and motor skills, the ability to make moral decisions and values necessary in life;

**WHEREAS**, aware of the vital role of the youth in nation building and the positive outcomes of involvement of the youth in sports programs, the City Government of Alaminos, Pangasinan intends to integrate youth development into sports development and to do so there is a need to amend Ordinance No 2021-26 for the purpose;

**WHEREAS**, Rule XXII of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that every LGU shall design and implement its own organizational structure and staffing pattern taking into consideration its priority needs, service requirements, and financial effectiveness, dynamism, and public accountability, subject to minimum standards and guidelines prescribed therefor by CSC;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, on motion of Councilor Apple Joy B. Tolentino, duly seconded by all members present

**BE IT ENACTED, AS IT IS HEREBY ENACTED BY THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD OF ALAMINOS CITY, PANGASINAN BY VIRTUE OF THE POWERS VESTED IN IT BY LAW, IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, THAT:**

**SECTION 1. TITLE.** — This ordinance shall be known as an *“Ordinance renaming the City Sports Development Office (CSDO) to City Youth and Sports Development Office (CYSDO) and retitling of the Sports Development Officer 1 to Youth Development Officer 1, with the same salary grade and qualification standards, thereby amending sections I, II, III and IV of Ordinance No. 2021-26, known as an Ordinance creating the Sports Development Office in the Local Government Unit of the City of Alaminos, Pangasinan.”*

**SECTION 2. AMENDMENTS:** Sections I, II, III and IV of Ordinance No. 2021-26 of the City of Alaminos, Pangasinan are hereby amended and read as follows:

a. **“Section I. TITLE.** — This ordinance shall be known as an “Ordinance creating the City Youth and Sports Development Office (CYSDO) in the Local Government Unit of the City of Alaminos, Pangasinan,”

b. **“Section II (a). CREATION OF THE CYSDO AND ITS FUNCTIONS.** — There shall be created a City Youth Sports Development Office (CYSDO) in the Local Government Unit of the City of Alaminos, Pangasinan as an independent department with the following staff:

c. **Section II (b)** The City Youth and Sports Development Office shall have the following functions:

1. Plan and formulate sports development programs geared towards the well-synchronized year-round calendar of sports activities in the city
2. Prepare athletic programs for prospective athletes to represent the city in Region 1 Athletic Association (R1AA), Palarong Pambansa and other sports competitions, including system of recruitment and trainings;
3. Assist the Local Chief Executive in the promotion of sports as part of health and fitness and encourage participation amongst the people;
4. Formulate guidelines for the conduct of sports events for persons with disability (PWDs);
5. Register and verify youth and youth-serving organizations. Provide technical assistance to the Local Youth Development Council in the formulation of the Local Youth Development Plan; Facilitate the election of Local Youth Development Plan representatives in the city. Upon being accredited by the National Youth Commission, conduct the mandatory and continuing training of Sangguniang Kabataan (SK) and Local Youth Development Council members in the city. In accordance with the programs jointly designated and implemented by the Civil Service Commission (CSC) and the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG). Provide technical, logistical and other support in the conduct of the mandatory and continuing training programs, and to such other programs and coordinate with the National Youth Commission (NYC) and DILG in terms of policy and PPA guidance; and
6. Perform such other functions as maybe prescribed by law, ordinance, or as the LCE, the DILG or the Commission may require.

**e. Section IV (2). DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS. — YOUTH AND SPORTS DEVELOPMENT OFFICER 1**

1. Assist in planning and formulating sports program geared towards a well-synchronized year-round calendar of sports activities for the city.
2. Assist in preparing various athletic programs for prospective athletes to represent the city at the R1AA, Palarong Pambansa and other sports competitions, including the system of recruitment, selection and training.
3. Assist in the promotion of sports as part of health and fitness and encourage participation amongst the people and formulate guidelines for the conduct of sports events for Persons with Disability.
4. Assist in the conduct the mandatory and continuing training of SK officials and LYDC members, in accordance with the programs jointly assigned and implemented by the National Youth Commission and Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG).
5. Assist in providing technical, logistical and other support in the conduct of mandatory and continuing training programs and to such other programs of the City Government, the Commission and the DILG.
6. Perform other duties that may be assigned from time to time.

**SECTION 3. EFFECTIVITY.** — This ordinance shall take effect upon approval and after completion of statutory requirements.
