ORDINANCE NO. 2023-20

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE SAFETY OF CHILDREN ABOARD MOTORCYCLE IN THE CITY OF ALAMINOS, PANGASINAN PURSUANT TO REPUBLIC ACT NO. 10666 OTHERWISE KNOWN AS, "CHILDREN'S SAFETY ON MOTORCYCLES ACT OF 2015"

EXPLANATORY NOTES

WHEREAS, Section 2 of Republic Act 10666, otherwise known as the "Children's Safety on Motorcycles Act of 2015", provides that it is the policy of the State to defend the right of children to assistance, including proper care and nutrition, and special protection from all forms of neglect, abuse, cruelty, exploitation, and other conditions prejudicial to their development.

Towards this end, the State shall pursue a more proactive and preventive approach to secure the safety of passengers, especially children, by regulating the operation of motorcycles along roads and highways."

WHEREAS, like any other locality in the country, motorcycles have evolved into more than just a mode of transportation in the city, but also serve as a mode of transportation for errands, school transportation, a business workhorse and, in extreme situations (which we do not condone), the family transportation;

WHEREAS, to ensure the safety of children aboard motorcycle in the city, there is a need provide measures for their safety;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Councilor Carolyn D. Sison, duly seconded by all members present

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, that:

SECTION 1. TITLE. — For brevity, this ordinance shall be known as the “*Safety of Children Aboard Motorcycle Ordinance of Alaminos City*”.

SECTION 2. SCOPE. — This ordinance shall cover all motorcycles plying the roads and streets within the territorial jurisdiction of the City of Alaminos, Pangasinan.

SECTION 3. DEFINITIONS. — As used in this ordinance, the following words shall mean:

- a. **Foot peg** – refers to a flat form attached to the motorcycles on which stand or brace the feet;
- b. **Motorcycle** – refers to any two-wheeled motor vehicle having one (1) or two (2) riding saddles;
- c. **Public roads** – refer to road designed by the national government or local government units as roads for public use, such as, but not limited to, national highways, provincial roads, city, municipal, and barangay streets; and
- d. **Rider** – shall mean any person riding on the motorcycle, scooter or moped, but not necessarily driving the same.

SECTION 4. PROHIBITION. — It shall be unlawful for any person to drive a two-wheeled motorcycle with a child on board on public roads where there is heavy volume of vehicles, there is a high density of fast-moving vehicles, or where a speed limit of more than 60 kilometer per hour (60 kph) is imposed, unless:

- a. The child passenger can comfortably reach his/her feet on the standard foot peg of the motorcycle;
- b. The child’s arms can reach around and grasp the waist of the motorcycle rider/driver; and
- c. The child is wearing a standard protective helmet referred to under Republic Act No. 10054, otherwise known as the “Motorcycle Helmet Act of 2009.”

SECTION 5. PENALTIES. — Any person found guilty of violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be penalized as follows:

| First Offense | : A fine of PhP 1,000.00 |
| Second Offense | : A fine of PhP 3,000.00 |
| Third Offense | : A fine of PhP 5,000.00 or one (1) month suspension of driver’s license |

Violations of these provisions beyond the third time shall result in the recommendation for the revocation of the offender’s Driver’s License at the Land Transportation Office (LTO).


SECTION 6. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. — If for any reason any provision, portion or part of this ordinance is found to be inconsistent with any law, other provisions or parts thereof not so affected shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 7. IMPLEMENTING BODY. — The Philippine National Police Alaminos City Police Station (PNP-ACPS) and the Public Order and Safety Office (POSO) shall be in charge of the overall implementation and monitoring of the implementation of this ordinance

SECTION 8. EFFECTIVITY. — This ordinance shall take effect upon approval and compliance with all statutory requirements in the enactment of an ordinance.
