ORDINANCE NO. 2024-16

**AN ORDINANCE INSTITUTIONALIZING THE CONDUCT OF
 ALAMINOS BARANGAY CARAVAN AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS
 THEREFOR**



WHEREAS, Section 9 of the 1987 Philippine Constitution provides that it is the policy of the state to promote a just and dynamic social order that will free the people from poverty through policies that provide adequate social services and an improved quality of life for all;

WHEREAS, Section 16 Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991," provides that, "Every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare.";

WHEREAS, the City Government of Alaminos, Pangasinan is committed to bring closer the frontline services of the city and other national agencies to the people at the barangay level through the conduct of Barangay Caravan;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of LBP Alex A. Recosana, duly seconded by all members of the Sangguniang Panlungsod present

BE IT ENACTED, AS IT IS HEREBY ENACTED, BY THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD in a session duly assembled, that:

SECTION 1. TITLE. — This Ordinance shall be known as the **“ALAMINOS BARANGAY CARAVAN (ABC) ORDINANCE OF 2024.”**

SECTION 2. PURPOSE. — This ordinance shall institutionalize the conduct of monthly Alaminos Barangay Caravan wherein frontline services of the city and other national government agencies, usually accessed, and availed in the city central business district, are brought to every barangay to make the said services accessible to the people.

SECTION 3. THE FOCAL OFFICE. — The Office of the City Mayor shall be the focal office for this undertaking. The City Mayor shall designate from among his/her staff or that of the Office of the City Administrator’s, a focal person in-charge of the overall planning and coordination with concerned local and national agencies for the conduct of the monthly Alaminos Barangay Caravan.

SECTION 4. SCHEDULE. — The Alaminos Barangay Caravan shall be conducted once a month. The specific schedule of which shall be determined by the Office of the City Mayor after proper coordination with concerned local and national offices/agencies.

SECTION 5. CLUSTERING OF BARANGAYS. — The thirty-nine (39) barangays of the city, will be divided into twelve (12) clusters corresponding to the twelve (12) months of the year. The following are the clustering of barangays for the conduct of the monthly Alaminos Barangay Caravan:

SECTION 6. ROTATIONAL HOSTING. — The barangays in each cluster will take turns in hosting the Alaminos Barangay Caravan. This approach ensures that every barangay shall be given the opportunity to host the Alaminos Barangay Caravan.

The frontline services brought by the Alaminos Barangay Caravan may be availed not only by the residents of the host barangay and those within the same clusters, but also by residents of other nearby barangays or any barangay, who would like to avail the free frontline services.

SECTION 7. FRONTLINE SERVICES. — The frontline services to be offered during the Alaminos Barangay Caravan shall be, but are not limited to, the following:

SECTION 8. WAIVER OF FEES. — The service fees duly imposed and collected by the Local Government Unit of the City of Alaminos for the services rendered during the conduct of Alaminos Barangay Caravan shall be waived. Fees and charges being collected by national government agencies shall remain.

SECTION 9. APPROPRIATIONS. — The initial fund to carry out the mandate of this Ordinance, shall be appropriated from the Gender and Development (GAD) fund of the City in the amount of at least One Million Five Hundred Thousand Pesos (PhP 1,500,000.00).

SECTION 10. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. — If any provision of this Ordinance or the application thereof is declared unconstitutional or invalid by a competent court, the remainder of this Ordinance shall not be affected thereby and shall remain valid and effective.

SECTION 11. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. — This Ordinance shall take effect upon compliance with the posting/publication requirements as enshrined in the Local Government Code.
