ORDINANCE NO. 2024-33

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 21 PARAGRAPH B OF CITY ORDINANCE NO. 2009-04 OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE "COMPREHENSIVE FISHERIES CODE OF THE CITY OF ALAMINOS 2009"

WHEREAS, in compliance with its mandated functions, the Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Alaminos, Pangasinan duly enacted Ordinance No. 2009-04 Entitled "Comprehensive Fisheries Code of the City of Alaminos, Pangasinan" on 04 September 2009;

WHEREAS, recent issuances and developments in the fisheries sector prompted the august body to consider amending some provisions of the above cited ordinance to consider the clamor of local fisherfolks, while ensuring the protection of the biodiversity and marine life within the territorial waters of the city;

WHEREAS, upon due consultation and deliberation on the matter and on motion of Councilor Walter M. Macaiba, duly seconded by all the members present

BE IT ENACTED, AS IT IS HEREBY ENACTED, BY THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD in a session duly assembled, that:

SECTION 1. Section 21 Paragraph (b) of Ordinance No. 2009-04 entitled “**Comprehensive Fisheries Code of the City of Alaminos 2009**”, which read as follows:

- b. Closed Season of catching Padas during the month of April – July of each year.

Hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 21, paragraph (b) Closed Season of catching Padas during the months of April to July of each year except for the following areas, to wit:

b.1 Start of registration and application of permit to gather Siganid Fry starts from January 2 to January 31 of each year.

b.2 Requirements for special permit on exempted areas:

1. Must be a resident fisherfolk of the City of Alaminos
2. Must be Fish R registered from the City Agriculture Office
3. Name must be included in the Master List of Siganid Fry Collector submitted by BFARMC Chairman concerned
4. Annual Catch Report (for renewal)
5. Residence Certificate (Cedula)
6. Barangay Clearance
7. Indorsement from BFARMC Chairman of the Barangay concerned

b.3. Additional requirements for renewal of special permit. Applicant must submit annual catch report to the City Agriculture Office - Fisheries Section with the following data to wit:

1. Total Annual Fish Catch
2. Number of fishing months
3. Number of fishing trips per month
4. Average number of fishing hour per trip
5. Average expenses per fishing trip
6. Catch Distribution (Volume) > Local (within Alaminos City) > Outside (sold to Trader)
7. Production Condition (Volume)
8. Fresh / Raw > Processed (Dried / Salted)
9. Estimated Gained Income

b.4. Regulations:

1. Start of Registration and Application of Permit to Gather Siganid Fry (Padas) shall be every January 02 and ends on the 31st of January, of each year, un less extended.
2. Applicants must endorse by the Barangay Captain of the concerned Barangay.
3. All fisherfolk on board the fishing boat as fish worker must be declared and with FishR for documentation purposes.
4. Fishing Boat and Fishing Gear (Modified Lift Net) must be Registered and Licensed.
5. A Special Permit to Gather Siganid Fry (Padas) will be issued to the fisherfolk applicant / licensee, from the City Agriculture Office, before he/she is allowed to conduct gathering of siganid fry on designated / allowed areas.
6. The Special Permit to Gather Siganid Fry is NON-TRANSFERABLE.
7. The Special Permit to Gather Siganid fry must always be carried by the licensee. No show of Special Permit during inspection and monitoring activity is tantamount to Unauthorized Fishing or Engaging in other Unauthorized Fisheries Activities.
8. The Licensee is permitted to conduct gathering of siganid fry on designated areas ONLY.

b. 5. Prohibitions. The following shall constitute violation on the prohibition of gathering siganid fry:

- a. Gathering of siganid fry by fisherfolk not listed on the masterlist and without Fish.
- b. Gathering siganid fry using unregistered and unlicensed fishing boat and fishing gear.
- c. Gathering of siganid fry without Special Permit issued by the City Government of Alaminos.
- d. Gathering of siganid fry in non-allowable or undesignated areas.
- e. Bringing minors (below 18 years old) during gathering of siganid fry (Padas).

• Application Fee	----	50.00
• Mayor's Permit	----	50.00
• Inspection Fee	----	200.00
• Fishing Gear License Fee	----	150.00 (Modified Lift Net)
• Fishing Boat Registration License Fee	----	Depend on Gross Registered Tonnage (GRT)
• Special Fishing Permit Fee	-----	250.00
• Mayor's Clearance	-----	50.00

b. 7. Penalties to be imposed in violation of this particular section are as follows:

1. Fine of Five Thousand Pesos (Php 5,000.00) per head.
2. Confiscation of Catch and Fishing Gear.
3. Impoundment of Fishing Boat and Registration of Fishing Boat (if Un-registered).
4. Filing of case in proper court.
5. Imprisonment of six (6) months or both fine and imprisonment.

b. 8. Non-Contest Clause. Par. 4 and 5 of b.7 of this Section will not be enforced so long as the administrative penalties are not contested.

SECTION 2. REPEALING CLAUSE. — All ordinances, resolutions, executive orders, rules and regulations and other administrative issuances, or the provisions thereof, which are contrary to, or inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed, or modified accordingly.

SECTION 3. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. — If any provision of this Ordinance is held invalid or unconstitutional, other provisions not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. — This Ordinance shall take effect upon compliance with statutory requirements for the enactment of an ordinance.


