ORDINANCE NO. 2021-18

AN ORDINANCE UPDATING CITY ORDINANCE NO. 02-2003, ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE OPERATION OF PIGGERY BUSINESS IN THE CITY OF ALAMINOS, PANGASINAN AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES"

EXPLANATORY NOTES

WHEREAS, one of the factors that contribute to the orderly and well-balanced growth of a community is an effective operational system of piggery business. The absence of which is recognized as a deterrent to the economic growth, a hazard to public health, and an irritant to the spirit and well-being of the inhabitants;

WHEREAS, it is the avowed policy of the City Government to uplift the socio-economic well-being of its inhabitants. In order to carry out this policy, it is necessary to liberalize the operation of piggery business in the City without prejudice to their general welfare;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Councilor Froebel A. Ranoy, duly seconded by Councilor Cirilo B. Radoc, Councilor Carolyn D. Sison, Councilor Dahlia M. de Leon, Councilor Michelle S. Segundera and Councilor Apolonia G. Bacay,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SANGGUNIANG PANLUNGSOD OF THE CITY OF ALAMINOS, PANGASINAN, IN SESSION ASSEMBLED, that:

SECTION 1. TITLE. – This ordinance shall be known as **"AN ORDINANCE UPDATING CITY ORDINANCE NO. 02-2003, ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE OPERATION OF PIGGERY BUSINESS IN THE CITY OF ALAMINOS, PANGASINAN AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."**

SECTION 2. DEFINITION OF TERMS. – The following words or phrases in addition to their usual meaning for purposes of this ordinance are adopted, and shall mean:

1. **Commercial Farm** is any farm with a swine population of at least:
 - 51 sow level and above and/or
 - 501 fattener and above
2. **Semi-commercial Farm** refers to at least one of the following:
 - Between 10-50 sow level
 - Between 41 to 500 fatteners
3. **Small-hold Farm** refers to the most commonly known as backyard farm, which refers to at least one of the following:
 - Less than 21 heads of adult and zero head of young (1-20 heads adult and zero young and below)
 - Less than 41 heads of young animals (1-40 heads young and below)
 - Less than 10 heads of adult and 22 heads of young (1-9 heads adult and 1-21 heads young and below)
4. Resident Veterinarians refer to veterinarians employed in more than 300 sow-level farms as defined in the IRR of Republic Act 8485 or the Animal Welfare Act of 1998.
5. **Boar-for-Hire** – refers to uncastrated male swine available to be hired for breeding.
6. **Piggery Farm** – refers to any parcel of land devoted for the raising or breeding of pigs/swine generally under the management of a tenant or owner.
7. **Fattening and Growing** – refers to the process whereby the hogs or piglets are fattened/grow up to suitable marketable size for slaughter purposes.

SECTION 3. PROHIBITED ACTS. - The following shall be prohibited under this Ordinance:

- 3.1 It shall be unlawful for any person or entity to operate a Backyard Piggery without a Location Clearance and Zoning Certificate from the Zoning Administrator, Sanitary Permit from the City Health Officer, Waste Management System Certificate, and Barangay Clearance/Certificate from the Barangay Council, and must be secured in the order/manner so stated.
- 3.2 It shall be unlawful for any person, owner, entity to conduct/operate a Commercial Piggery (large scale) business without a Waste-water Treatment Facility, a Locational Clearance or Zoning Certificate from the Zoning Administrator, Sanitary Permit for the building owner and Health Certificate for the workers from the City Health Officer, Barangay Clearance/Certificate from the Barangay Council, Business Permit/License from the Office of the City Treasurer.
- 3.3 It shall be unlawful for any person, entity, or owner of Commercial Piggery (large scale) to operate without securing an Environmental Compliance Certificate (ECC) from the Department of Environment and Natural Resources through the Community Environment and Natural Resources Office (CENRO).
- 3.4 It shall be unlawful for any person, entity, or owner to establish a piggery in an area located not less than 25-meter radius from sources of ground and surface drinking water.

SECTION 4. IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS. - The City Mayor shall promulgate Implementing Rules and Regulations as he deems necessary to attain the objective of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE. - Existing piggery project whether backyard or commercial shall prospectively comply with the provisions of this Ordinance within six (6) months.

SECTION 6. PENALTY. - Any person, owner or entity found violating any provision of this Ordinance shall be fined as follows:

- First offense - PhP 1,000.00
- Second offense - PhP 2,000.00
- Third offense - PhP 5,000.00

For succeeding offenses, revocation or suspension of license shall be imposed upon the offender for the third offense.


SECTION 7. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. - Should any provision of this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 8. REPEALING CLAUSE. All Ordinances, rules and regulations which are in conflict or inconsistent hereof, are hereby repealed and modified accordingly.

SECTION 9. EFFECTIVITY. - This Ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days after the date of its publication in a newspaper of general circulation and posting in bulletin boards of 3 conspicuous places in the City of Alaminos, Pangasinan.
